Camp Borden.	14-6-45		<p>0900 hours, ceiling unlimited, and visibility 5 miles, inslight haze. Flying washed in at 0930 hours, and washed out at 1530 hours. Flying time 64.15 hours.</p> <p>A Refresher Course consisting of 25 Pilots, who had been recalled from the Reserve, and 3 other Pilots held over from the 1st Refresher Course, started their course to-day. The graduates of this course are expected to carry out further flying and physical conditioning training upon leaving this Unit, and in due course will probably be posted to the Pacific Theatre of war.</p> <p>A District Court Martial was convened at Camp Borden to-day for the purpose of trying charges against R.65561 Flight Sergeant Fulford, C.H. The President of the Court Martial was Squadron Leader Howard and the Members were Squadron Leader Woolfenden and Flight Lieutenant DeSarre. The Prosuceting Officer was Flight Lieutenant Worrall of No. 1 Air Command, and the Defending Officer, Flight Lieutenant Claridge, also of No.1 Air Command.</p> <p>This Unit was visited to-day by Squadron Leader Duchennay and Flight Lieutenant Seal of No. 1 Air Command for the purposes of making an Accounts Section Inspection.</p>
