Dear Sir:-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 28th ultimo forwarding statement of amount of indebtedness owing by the Bridge River Power Company Limited for 125.71 acres of land from Slosk Indian Reserve No. 1, of the Seton Lake Band, together with compensation for Indian improvements and interest from 13th April, 1922 to 13th December, 1925, the total amounting to \$3,895.15.

I am now herewith forwarding to you the cheque of the British Columbia Electric Railway Company, of Vancouver, for this amount, dated the 8th instant.

The above mentioned Company has taken over the charter of the Bridge River Power Company, but requests that the Grant covering the property should be made in the name of the Bridge River Power Company Limited.
