Dear Mr Meighan:-

Do you remember my telling you at Ottawa some years ago that I was engaged in research to find a mechanical means to apply the Archimedean Principle to electricity?

My theory was that if this could be done it would mean the multiplication of electrical energy and its production in unlimited quantity, anywhere and without water or steam power.

After ten years of research, I have at last solved my problem and have a large machine now erected here with to demonstrate.

While my engineer has tested it and is sure of the results desired, the machine is not yet ready to show the Government engineers. It may be next week.

In the meanwhile the elections have come to the front before I was ready to take a hand. I want to finance you and a new party which will have a new form of Government that will do away completely with politics and politicians.

As soon as I am ready to let it go, I will be in a financial position to put up as many millions as you will need to cover the Country and your slogan will be REVENUE WITHOUT TAXATION. It is too long a story to put in a letter, and I suggest that you may be in this neighbourhood in the near future and will come and see me when we can thrash the subject out.

Parliament and Government as presently constituted is to my mind a failure and calls for a new system. The only excuse for universal suffrage is taxation and if the people are not called upon to pay taxes, it is unnecessary to go through the form of consulting them, and the few men in the country who are capable of running it in a business way, yourself and the heads of the great corporations forming the Government, while we have a legislative body consisting of the heads of the Church, courts, professions, Boards of Trade and the labor organizations in each province, being ex officio members of the Legislature, which would meet at short intervals to pass necessary laws given them to pass, by the Government.

I must have a great organization to handle my affairs, because my revenues from royalties, coming in from 64 countries will be very much greater than that of Canada, and I would like you to head it.
