

Conditions of application  
for loans:

Municipality must satisfy Minister  
of Finance that proposed pro-  
jects are self-liquidating;

Municipality must present certif-  
icate, approved by province,  
demonstrating urgent need and  
and that relief of unemployment  
locally will be assisted;

Project and loan application re-  
quire approval of Lieutenant-  
Governor-in-Council of province  
in which municipality is situ-  
ated;

Province so concerned must under-  
take to guarantee payment by  
municipality of principal and  
interest;

This Act provides means for under-  
taking much-needed municipal  
projects and improvements on  
terms more advantageous than any  
previously available;

To date, five provinces have under-  
taken to guarantee loans for  
important projects; the Govern-  
ment of Ontario, claiming "un-  
fortunate experiences" in the  
past, has refused to guarantee  
loans under the Act.
