Ottawa, 2nd March, 1908.

Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge receipt of your letters of the 18th ultimo, No 113, and in reply to say that you may purchase 150 bushels of seed oats for the Agency and farmers; 200 bushels for the Indians of Beardy's and Okemasis Reserves and 100 bushels seed wheat for young Indians starting farming on Beardy's and One Arrow's Reserves.

The Indians who are supplied with seed should be given to understand that they will be required to refund the cost from their next crop and from sales of cattle, or return a like quantity to you and they should each be required to sign an agreement to this effect.
