Correspondence relating to the issuance of licences and the fees paid, accounts and returns of licences issued, bonds and certificates submitted by persons applying for licences and certain related documents, 1801-1867, form a composite series. They have been sorted into sub-series according to type of licence or activity and within those either alphabetically by name of applicant or numerically by the sequence of the bond or licence.

The Collector of Customs issued certain types of licences -- notably to auctioneers, hawkers and pedlars. His returns of licences issued rarely give names of individuals.

Certain sub-series have been indexed. The indexes are available in the Reference Room.
