A WAIL FROM NEBRASKA. The Platte River Overflows Its Banks —People Who Escaped Freezing to Death in Danger of Being Swept Away by the Flood.

Death in panger of Being Swept Away by the Flood. Omaha, Neb., March 27....For several days an ice gorge has been forming on Platte River, near North Bend. On Fri-day the waters suddenly rose above the barks and swept away the Union Pacific railroad for a mile and a half. The water rose several feet. In North Bend the people took refuge in the railroad depot, ing off the people of that place from all communication. The whole valley of the beople of that place from all communication. A large quantity of ice is pouring out of the loop River, and is carried by the flood over the country, moving down telegraph poles and destroying property. 
