FOR HOUSEKEEPERS.

There was an exceedingly small attendance of farmers at the market here this morning. The light offerings is partly due to the bad roads and the fact that farmers as a rule have very little produce to sell. We need not expect any large attendance till Easter.

Hay and Straw—Only about 10 loads on sale, and as yesterday's offerings were light, the price advanced 50c to \$1 per ton, selling at \$9 to \$10 per ton; the demand is good.

Butter and Eggs—The offerings in this line are light with prices as quoted; there is an excellent demand for both butter and eggs.

Apples and Vegetables—Very few of the first-named article on sale; prices are unchanged.

Potatoes—More plentiful, and prices are inclined to be easier. 70c per bag was paid for a couple of choice loads.

Poultry—In fair supply, at 11c to 12c per lb for turkeys; geese, ducks and chickens hold their own, with prices steady.

Dressed Hogs—About 20 on sale; mostly at \$7.50 to \$7.75 per cwt, and in a few instances \$8 per cwt, as per bag was paid for a couple of choice loads.

Meats—Firm; the supply is fair. Wool—Easier in price; washed selling at 11c to 12c per lb; unwashed at 6c to 7c per lb.

AMERICAN MARKETS.

CHICAGO, Feb. 24—Grain prices tumbled at the opening of the board of trade today. Then the bears gave them a vigorous push and everything went downhill and struck low level with a pretty hard bump. The warm weather and prospects of grain in plenty was the cause of the slump. May wheat closed with a net loss of 1/8c. May corn 1/8c. May oats 1/8c. Local receipts of wheat were 11 cars. 1 of contract grade; Minneapolis (three days) and local (two days) reported 93 cars, making a total for the three points of 94 cars, against 85 cars last Monday and 84 cars last year. The many receipts for tomorrow and three days were 1,050,000 bu., compared with 850,000 bu. last Monday and 840,000 bu. last year. Seaboard clearances in wheat and flour equaled 230,000 bu. The bid this morning for 20 loads taken for export. Estimated receipts for tomorrow: Wheat, 65 cars; corn, 25 cars; oats, 25 cars; 50,000 lbs.
