

To Check the Massacres. "About nine o'clock the next morning, Dr. Reigroizky received a telegram from M. Branson, a member of the lower house of parliament, saying that Interior Minister Stolypin the previous night had telegraphed to the authorities to check the massacres immediately. Dr. Reigroizky showed the despatch to an official, who angrily answered: "We know ouyself when to re-establish order. Do no timagine that you Jews have the Jewish dictatorship of Bialystok." "The excesses were resumed at 10:30 by a policeman at the head of 30 roughs who fired upon a certain house saying, brothers the Jews have been shoot-ing from this house." "The roughs threw paving stones through the windows and the troops fied vollers at the house. The rioting did not cease until M. Stchepkin arrived Saturday afternoor."
