During the past week both China and Japan have made formal declarations of war. These it is true were but mere formalities as some pretty hard fighting had been going on both on land and sea for nearly two weeks before these proclamations were issued.

The war thus far has been characterized by great brutality and great loss of life. The destruction of the transport carrying the British flag appears to have been especially so. One thousand Chinese soldiers were on board, and these threatened to kill the captain and crew if they attempted to take the ship to Japan as they were ordered to do by the officers of the Japanese cruiser.
