WORLD NEWS IN BRIEF.

Five miners were terribly burned by an explosion in a colliery near Hay and narrowly escaped death. James Martin, head baker at Hamilton Asylum, was struck on the head with an axe by a patient in the Asylum on Saturday afternoon and died at night.

The schooner Elwood Burton, commanded by Capt. Williams, of St. John, was grounded on a rocky shoal in the Massachusetts coast on Friday night. The schooner, with three of the crew perished. The mate and two of the men were rescued by a crew from the life-saving station.

A special train running from New Glasgow to Stellarton, Oct. 4th, struck two young boys who were on the track about midnight. One of them, John McDonald, of New Glasgow, was killed and sent to pieces. The other boy, a fellow Canadian, named James, was severely injured.

Samuel McKee, aged 75, of Charlottetown, a patient for the past two weeks in the Falmouth Hospital, the insane, was found dead last Thursday in the bathroom with his head horribly battered and a piece of tin board, with which the deed was committed, lying near his body. A George Hanson, was found with blood-stained shirt, proclaiming himself undoubtedly the slayer of McKee.
