This fourth volume contains very good notices of books, papers and society proceedings relating to Canada. The analysis and criticism of the books reviewed are generally made in a very impartial manner and can be relied upon. It praises whoever deserves praise, and criticises whatever has to be criticised.

The works of real merits are thoroughly studied and ample quotations are made from them. This publication is a valuable addition to our poor stock of reference books and should be found in the shelves of every student's library.

During a recent extensive tour throughout Canada, the author gathered much *special* information regarding its boundless resources for Trade and Commerce—Its immense Field for the Industrious and Enterprising—Its Travelling facilities—Its Scenery—Incidents of Travel—Its Engineering features, and everything else calculated to make this volume useful and interesting to all, many places of importance having been visited and carefully noted.

Besides this book Mr. Haldane is the author of several very popular Lime-light Lectures, including those entitled : — "Origin and Development of Steam Navigation"; "Life at Sea in a Peninsular and Oriental Mail Liner"; "Ocean Bed Scenery"; "Origin and Development of the Railway System"; and "3,800 Miles from East to West on British Soil", the information and lantern slides for which were gathered during the tour referred to.
