BUSINESS VISITS FROM CANADA AND A PROVINCIAL TRADE
MISSION FROM ONTARIO. SOME COLOMBIAN INVESTMENT
AND HENCE PURCHASING HAS BEEN PLACED ON HOLD UNTIL
THE SITUATION STABILIZES, ALTHOUGH MANY ESSENTIAL
COMMERCIAL TRANSACTIONS WILL PROCEED AS PLANNED.
THE COMMERCIAL DIVISION WILL SEEK TO ASSIST CANADIAN
COMPANIES TO MAINTAIN AND ADVANCE THEIR BUSINESS
INTERESTS DESPITE THE DIFFICULTIES WHICH CURRENTLY
APPLY.
