The success of democracy in South Africa requires ongoing international support. Summit leaders will discuss South Africa's re-entry into the international community, as well as new trade and investment opportunities.

As in previous years, the pressing political issues of the day will be reviewed by summit leaders and their ministers. Of particular importance are the situations in Bosnia, Haiti, Rwanda and North Korea.

Russian President Boris Yeltsin will join G-7 leaders on the final day of the summit for a discussion of such pressing political issues as Bosnia, North Korea, the Middle East, the United Nations and peacekeeping, Rwanda and Haiti.
