

"open door" policy will likely continue in one form or another. In response to the events of June, 1989, the World Bank - a major source of development funds and policy advice for China - suspended all loans. It is believed that in 1990, the World Bank and the G-7 countries may resume funding to China on a project-by-project basis, with careful monitoring, to assure that projects benefit China's people, and support the economic reform initiated in the past decade.
