In the fucceeding year, Colonel Bradstreet caused another pallisadoe fort to be crected, which he call'd Fort Eagle. It is feituate on the banks of the Wood Creek, its form, a regular fquare, with four baftions; each exteriour fide, about fixty yards in length; it was furrounded by a wide ditch, communicating with the creek; a crofs which, a very fine ftrong dam was made, by which means, the ditch. furrounding the fort, was kept full of water ; for a work of its kind, 'tis the best constructed of any in our possession. On the furrender of Ofwego to the enemy, this, together with all our other posts, beyond the German Flats, was demolished by order of the Earl of Loudon
