

A copy of the report of the Committee on the Government of the District of Columbia, which was presented to the House of Representatives on the 15th of February, 1890, and which is printed in the report of the House of Representatives on the subject of the District of Columbia, is herewith submitted for the information of the Senate.

When the proposed amendments were introduced and read, as above, the Senate passed the following resolution: "Resolved, That the Committee on the District of Columbia be and they are authorized to report to the Senate on the subject of the District of Columbia, and to make such recommendations as they may deem proper."
