"With a view of quelling the rebellion as foon as poffible, it is become highly neceffary that the most *speedy junction of the two armies should be effected*, Sc."

" It is his Majefty's pleafure that you put under the command of Lieut. Gen. Burgoyne, the grenadiers and light infantry, &c. together with as many Canadians and Indians as may be thought neceffary for this fervice; and after having furnished him, in the fullest and completest manner, with artillery, stores, provisions, and every other article necessary for
