

LEATHER MARKET.
Toronto, June 26.—Leather.—The tone of the market continues firm, an advance in prices is noted. Local dealers quote: Sole leather, medium, per lb. 30c to 31c; No. 2, 28c to 29c; No. 3, 26c to 27c; calfskins, French, \$1.15 to \$1.20; French kip, No. 1, \$1.20 to \$1.25; No. 2, \$1.00 to \$1.05; No. 3, \$0.80 to \$0.85; harness, union oak tanned, No. 1, 30c to 31c; No. 2, 28c to 29c; light, 25c to 26c; dark, 23c to 24c; degas, per lb. 3c to 3 1/2c.

WHEAT MARKET.
London, Wednesday, June 27.—There was a good demand for the 18 loads of hay offered; prices ranged from \$10 to \$10 1/2 per ton. The supply of oats was light; the few loads offered sold at \$1.15 to \$1.20 per cwt. A couple of loads of strawberries were offered, selling at 80c per box; it is expected that there will be a large number of loads offered at Thursday's market.

WEEKLY REVIEW.
The markets held here the past six days were well attended by the farmers and buyers. Trade was active in nearly every line. There was not much change in prices from those paid last week. Grain—Oats are not coming in as freely as a week or two ago; there seems to be quite a large quantity of the crop to be marketed; the dealers say that the farmers will make a mistake if they expect higher prices, as the crop has been sold at \$1.15 to \$1.20 per cwt. There is only an occasional load of wheat offered.

Hay and Straw—Hay is selling well at present; prices are \$9 to \$10 per ton. Most of the loads are sold at \$9 1/2. Straw is dull at \$5 to \$5 1/2 per ton. The farmers say that those who have to pay for hay, which they claim will not be over two-thirds as large as last year. While the rains the past three or four weeks have greatly benefited the growing crop, the cold weather during the months of April and May retarded the growth, which accounts for the light crop.

Butter and Eggs—Butter is a shade firmer; sales are made at 17c to 18c for crocks and 18c to 19c for pound rolls. Eggs are easier, at 16c to 17c per dozen, whole.

Potatoes—Old potatoes are scarce, at 15c to 16c per bag. New potatoes are not yet in the market.

Poultry—Spring chickens have the call in this line; they sell at 10c to 11c alive, and 12c to 13c per pair dressed. Old fowl are dull, at 8c to 9c per pair.

Meat—Beef is a shade firmer; sales are made at 10c to 11c for the fore quarter, and 12c to 13c for the hind quarter. Pork is easier, at 14c to 15c per lb.

Wool—The bulk of the crop has been marketed for the season; prices at present are 20c to 21c for washed and 18c to 19c for unwashed.
