

## SHELDON TALKS ON INDUSTRIAL UNREST

THE DE LONDON, ONTARIO, SATURDAY, NOVEMBER 1, 1919.

Employer and Employee Question Must Be Tackled

"Industrial Unrest" was the subject dealt with in the address delivered by A. F. Sheldon in the Auditorium last evening, before a large assemblage of people, it being the third and last of his series of lectures given under the auspices of the Life Underwriters' Association and the London Advertising Club.

sociation and the London Advertising Club.

"The present is not a time for fooling," said Mr. Sheldon, "and the employer-employe question must be faced seriously and the problem tackled fearlessly. Before there can be a platform upon which the Government, capital and labor may stand with equality and with a perfect understanding between them, several important changes must be made by all of the parties. The labor unions should change some of their man-made laws so that they will conform to natural laws. Capitalists, as a whole, should revise or discard several of their standardized customs, and the government also should change a few of its laws.

ment also should change a few of its laws.

"I sincerely believe that the time is not far distant," continued the speaker, "when the government, or, in other words, organized society, intercedes between the employer class and the employe class and helps in the elimination of the misunderstandings which at present stand as a barrier between their co-operation. Of course, the two factions must realize first that selfishness cannot exist if a combine is formed, and that to serve self one must serve the other. Then, when that time comes, heaven will seem very much closer to the people of this continent."

Four Classes in United States

An analysis of employers in the United States, the speaker's native country, was made, and four main classes were defined, three of which, Mr. Sheldon stated, were autocrats. In the first class are included the employers who consider the men on their payrolls as mere "hired hands"—those who think of their men as they would of a ton of coal. "Men of that type," said the speaker, "are most certainly Bolsheviki breeders." The second class consists of those who endeavor to buy and produce morale among their employees by means of good wages and a continuous system of economic promotion, and in whose establishments the spirit of moral relationship between the executives and laborers is prohibited by the rule "Business is business."
