GLADSOME DAYS FOR GRAIN BEARS. Prices Slump Again in Chicago—Spot Offerings of Spot Corn.

Chicago, Nov. 18.—It was a field day for bears in all the grain pits today and wheat reached new bottom figures for the period which has followed the end of government control and resumption of future delivery trading.

Liquidating sales of corn and oats acted as the chief immediate depressing factor. Wheat finished nervous, 3c to 4c net lower, with December 11.80% to 11.90%, and March 11.85% to 11.95%.

CARVELL WILL NOT PRESIDE AT HEARING. Not to Be Chairman at Telephone Case Sitings—Affiliation Protest One Reason.

Ottawa, Nov. 18.—(By Canadian Press).—F. B. Carvell, chairman of the board of railway commissioners, it was learned today, has decided not to sit as chairman of the application of the Bell Telephone Company for an increase in rates.

Mr. Carvell presided over the hearing in Ottawa, at which the Bell Telephone Company opened its case. Some exception was taken to the chief commissioner sitting on the case because of his connection as director and shareholder of the Bell Telephone Company.

Mr. Carvell, however, was of the opinion that there was no reason why he should stay out of the case, because the New Brunswick company is operating under a provincial charter and does not come within the jurisdiction of the railway board.

Only in Phone Case. Hearings in connection with the telephone rates case have this month been held in Toronto, Hamilton and Montreal, with Assistant Chief Commissioner McLean presiding. It is understood that in view of his unavoidable absence from these hearings, and the objections which have been raised, Mr. Carvell has decided not to sit as chairman of the board during the further hearing of this particular application.
