SEPTEMBER .- Some years ago we gave a piece of advice which it has been suggested should be repeated. Canada thistles should be mown down when they are in full bloom or a little past; one cutting will generally suffice. Large quantities have frequently been destroyed by once mowing, and it has been equally successful on white alders when cut in the same forward state. White daisies or johnsworts are hard to exter-minate. Where a good supply of plaster or gypsum is scattered over the land white or red clover may take the place of johnswort. But there is nothing better than sheep for destroying weeds. By repeatedly pasturing with sheep the daisy will disappear, so will johnswort and other less troublesome weeds. You may destroy your weeds and feed your sheep.
