

THE SEVENTY-THIRD ANNUAL REPORT OF THE
MONTREAL GENERAL HOSPITAL.

The Seventy-third Annual Meeting of the Corporation of the Montreal General Hospital was held in the Governors' Hall of the Institution, on Tuesday, the 21st of May, 1895, Mr. F. Wolferstan Thomas, President, in the chair. The Secretary read the following Report, which was adopted and ordered to be printed for circulation amongst the subscribers:—

LADIES AND GENTLEMEN OF THE CORPORATION OF THE
MONTREAL GENERAL HOSPITAL :

I have the honor of presenting a brief report of the Receipts and Expenditure of the Hospital and of the proceedings of the Governors for the year which terminated on the 30th of April, 1895.

The ordinary income of the year was	\$56,218 71
The ordinary expenditure was	60,122 75
Showing an excess of expenditure of	<u>\$3,904 04</u>
Comparing the ordinary expenditure of 1894-5	\$60,122 75
With that of 1893-94	<u>66,434 17</u>
The latter exceeds the former by	<u>\$6,311 42</u>

An analysis of the year's outlay shows that the chief items of diminished disbursements have been provisions, \$4,248.33; drugs and medicines, \$2,100.13; salaries and wages, \$2,670.49. There has been an increased expenditure in the following items: Insurance, \$1,006.80 (covering a period of three years); furniture, \$1,005.03; light, \$204.70. A good deal of the diminution of expenditure has been owing to the transfer of infectious cases to the city.
