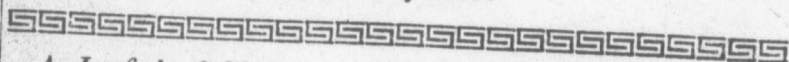


# YANKEE AMALGAMATION.
