the permittee shall submit to the Supervisory Engineer, or other officer named by the Superintendent General, a statement containing detailed information as to the character of the operations to be conducted on the location, including a description of the process to be employed in collecting the required geological information, the method by which such information is to be conveyed to the Department, and the uses, purposes and disposal of the cores which may be obtained. Unless full and detailed information is submitted by the permittee under this section, and unless such information is satisfactory to and accepted by the Supervisory Engineer, or other officer, the cash bond furnished by the applicant shall be subject to forfeiture in the discretion of the Superintendent General.

- (2) The permittee shall from time to time, as prospecting and drilling operations on the location proceed, furnish the Superintendent General, free of cost, and in the manner determined, with all geological and other data and reports obtained as a result of such prospecting and drilling, also with the logs of the several wells drilled, the conditions ascertained, and the results obtained.
- operations on his location to a sufficient extent, and with sufficient frequency, to indicate that the structure is not favourable for the production of oil or gas, but has not expended in such operations the amount prescribed by these regulations, the Superintendent General may, in his discretion, allow the permittee to relinquish his permit, and may release the bond furnished, upon evidence, duly
