Copy of Reso'ution passed by the National Divi-ion S. of T. of Noth America at the session held in Montreal ia June 1866:

Resolved,-That Section 1 of Art. III. of the Constitution of Subordinate Divisions be amended ty strikiug out the word "male" in the first line of said section, and by adding to said section the words "provided that females shall not be admitted to membership within the jurisdiction of any Grand Division unless permission be first granted by a two thirds vote of the Grand Division; nor in any Subordinate Division unless the Division shall so decide by a two third vote after two weeks notice.
