THE OCEAN HORROR.

Today's news concerning the loss of the Lusitania shows that the loss of life was very much greater than was reported by last night's cables. If the Admiralty estimate of 1,600 lives lost is correct the tragedy is utterly appalling, and calls for swift vengeance upon the perpetrators of the devilish deed.

CANADA'S LOSS

Up to midnight last night the names of 2,988 Canadians who were killed or wounded at Tyne had been given out. Of 297 officers, 73 were killed, while the casualty list thus far given out contains the names of only 97 privates killed.

THE LUSITANIA

Only cowardice or self-interest of the basest sort could prevent the United States from bringing Germany sharply to account for the destruction of the lives of American citizens when the Lusitania was torpedoed and sunk by a German submarine.

When the news came last night that the Lusitania had been torpedoed and that instead of those on board being saved, as had been at first reported, many hundreds, perhaps even more than a thousand, lives had been lost, the world was stunned because there was nothing in the recognized rules of warfare to warrant such an atrocious act as the sinking of this vessel, having on board more than two thousand people who were non-combatants, and who included women and children, as well as many people of prominence in Canada and the United States.
