

APPOINTMENTS.

Rev. W. R. Brown has been appointed to the Mission of Iron Hill; Rev. R. Kerr to the Mission of Potton; and the Rev. T. A. Haslam to the Rectory of Granby.

VACANCIES.

The Rectories of Phillipsburg and Bedford, and the Missions of Brome and Sabrevois are vacant.

DEATHS.

We have to report the death of the Rev. James Jones. This venerable Missionary was for some years superannuated, and died a very old man, and full of years. The extensive Mission which was formerly under his charge is now subdivided into the Incumbencies of Bedford, Stanbridge and West Farnham, and included also a part of the Rectory of Clarenceville. Some thirty years ago Mr. Jones, even then an old man, undertook a journey to England, and with singular success raised a large amount of money, which was appropriated to the erection of churches or parsonages in such centres within his Mission as gave promise of future importance. And to his efforts on that occasion must be assigned much of that prosperity which the above-named Incumbencies have since enjoyed.

We have also to record the deaths of Messrs. Hiram S. Foster and Charles Lindsay, faithful and exemplary members of the Church, who, at the time of their deaths, were members of the Diocesan Synod.

CHURCHES.

The Rev. J. Ker has built a church in the eastern part of his Mission of Glen Sutton.

The churches at Abbotsford and Clarenceville have been remodelled in accordance with modern taste, and greatly improved.

PARSONAGES.

A Parsonage has been erected in the Mission of Glen Sutton, and another is being built in North Shefford.

ENDOWMENTS.

With the exception of Abbotsford, Granby and West Farnham, no other Parishes seem to have made any increase in the amount of their endowments.

In connection with this subject the following resolutions have been adopted by the Deanery:

1. That it be recommended to the Synod to resolve, that in the case of every country Parish where the endowment does not yield \$400 per annum, the Offertory on the first Sunday of each month be appropriated in each of such cases to the formation or increase of its endowment, until it shall yield annually the above-named sum of \$400.
