Conference adjourned with prayer by Bro. G. Braun.

Afternoon Session

This session was opened with devotional exercises led by Bishop Horn, reading of the first directions for preachers, by the secretary, and prayer by Bro. T. C. Meckel.

The devotional committee reported that Bro. H. Dierlamm is to preach to-night.

The report was adopted.

T. C. Meckel, Corresponding Secretary of the Missionary Society, addressed the conference in the interests of the missionary cause, and received \$1,503 in cash and subscriptions towards the Mission debt.

Fraternal greetings were sent to the Wisconsin Conference through Bro. T. C. Meckel.

E. E. Rife and L. K. Eidt were received into the itinerancy.

M. L. Wing, delegate to the Dominion Temperance Alliance reported that no convention was held this year by said body.

The matter regarding the Parry Sound parsonage was referred to the committee on appropriations.

M. L. Wing offered the following resolution in reference to the Waterdown church:

Since the society at Waterdown, Hamilton Mission, has been so weakened by the removals and deaths of members, so that no services are held there, and the said church would under circumstances only dilapidate therefore.

Resolved, That the matter of the Waterdown church be referred to the P. Elder of the South District, the preacher of Hamilton-Mission and Father J. Yenni, to act according to their best judgement and to report to the next conference.

The Stratford church matter was referred to the committee on Ways and Means.

J. C. Morlock was appointed to receive the educational collections and pay them over to Prof. S. L. Umbach.
