

Mr. Burke first joined the Force on March 3rd, 1898, and served until April 8th, 1902, when he purchased his discharge and returned to his home in Ireland on the death of his father. For some time while stationed at Regina he acted as Provost and was promoted to the rank of Corporal. After travelling to Ireland he returned again to Canada and resided in Alberta where he remained until his death.

Regimental No. 3699—Ex-Constable Hollace Henry Pickering

On September 23rd, 1936, Mr. H. H. Pickering died at Fournier's Ranch near Dawson Y.T., aged 60 years.

Mr. Pickering first joined the Force at Moncton, N.B., on April 26th, 1900, and took his discharge on August 31st the following year. Subsequent to leaving the N.W.M.P. Mr. Pickering resided permanently in the Yukon Territory until the time of his death.

Regimental No. 9632—Ex-Constable Michael Francis Greville

Mr. M. F. Greville passed away at Edmonton, Alta., on October 6th, aged 39 years.

Joining the R.C.M. Police on Nov. 10th, 1920, after serving for a period of three years and six months, Mr. Greville left the Force on May 15th, 1924 to enter the employ of the Alberta Liquor Control Board. Prior to his engagement in the R.C.M. Police, Mr. Greville had also served on active service in the Great War for approximately three years with the Canadian Expeditionary Force.

Regimental No. 11230—Ex-Constable Jack McKay

Mr. Jack McKay passed away after a long illness on November 15th, 1936, at the Royal Ottawa Sanatorium.

Mr. McKay joined the Force on November 30th, 1931, and was invalided on July 7th, 1935. During his period of service he was stationed at Regina, Vancouver, Edmonton and Ottawa.
