

fourth Day of June, One thousand seven hundred and twenty-two, and which, by several subsequent Acts, made in the Sixteenth, Twenty-fourth, and Thirty-first Years of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Second, and the Fourth, Twelfth, and Nineteenth Years of His present Majesty's Reign, was amended, and further continued until the Twenty-ninth Day of September, One thousand seven hundred and eighty-five, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament, shall be, and the same is hereby further continued from the Expiration thereof, until the Twenty-ninth Day of September, One thousand seven hundred and ninety-two, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament.

Further continued until Sept. 29, 1792, etc.

II. And be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That an Act, made in the Fourth Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Second, intituled, An Act for granting an Allowance upon the Exportation of *British* made Gunpowder, which was to continue in Force for five Years from the Twenty-fourth Day of June, One thousand seven hundred and thirty-one, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament; and which, by several subsequent Acts, made in the Tenth, Sixteenth, Twenty-fourth, and Thirty-first Years of His said Majesty's Reign, and the Fourth, Twelfth, and Eighteenth Years of His present Majesty's Reign, was further continued until the Twenty-ninth Day of September, One thousand seven hundred and eighty-five, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament, shall be, and the same is hereby further continued from the Expiration thereof until the Twenty-ninth Day of September, One thousand seven hundred and ninety-two, and from thence to the End of the then next Session of Parliament.

III. And be it further enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That an Act, made in the Ninth Year of the Reign of His late Majesty King George the Second, intituled, An Act for further encouraging and regulating the Manufacture of *British* Sail Cloth; and for the more effectual securing the Duties now payable on Foreign Sail Cloth im-
