
NOTICE OF REMOVAL.





the Commissioners appointed and acting under that certain Act of the Legislature of that part of the Province of Canada heretofore constituting and called the Province of Upper Canada, passed in the second year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act for the Protection of the Lands of the Crown in this Province, from trespass and injury," and also under and by virtue of that certain Act of the Legislature of the Province of Canada, passed in the twelfth year of Her Majesty's Reign, intituled "An Act to explain and amend an Act of the Parliament of the late Province of Upper Canada," passed in the second year of Her Majesty's reign, intituled 'An Act for the Protection of the Lands of the Crown in this Province from trespass and injury,' and to make further provision for that purpose," have, under and by virtue of the said Statutes, found and determined that you have illegally possessed yourself of, and are unlawfully in the possession and occupation of the Land aforesaid,—the same being a piece or parcel of Land for which no Grant, Lease, Ticket either of Location or Purchase, or Letter of License of Occupation, hath been, or hath issued either under the Great Seal or by or from the proper Department of the Provincial Government to which the issuing of the same at any time belonged or belongs; You are therefore hereby required to remove from the occupation of the said Land on or at such day after the day of the service of this Notice, as shall allow you clear thirty days at the least from and after and excluding the day of the service of this Notice-according to the form of the said Statutes-otherwise you shall be dealt with according to the said Statutes.
