I have to acknowledge the receipt
of your letter of the 14th instant, and
to inform you that the Merchants
having been under license to
be charged with any condition
expressed in the license to the
effect that the Indians were to
have such timber as they required
for building purposes it is not in
the power of the Department to
assent to the request of Mr Kirk.

You might however communicate
to Mr Kirk who might possibly
obtain a sufficient quantity of timber
from the land to make the required
number of boards for a house for this Chief.
