He states that the contention of Marie Obumseawin, as expressed in her letter, that section 20 of the Indian Act only has its application when the Reserve is subdivided into lots, is not, in his opinion, tenable, as the case of any other recognized title is expressly mentioned, and you should advise the woman accordingly.
