Dear Dr. Cash:-

In reply to your communication of the 11th instant, with reference to the N.E.1/4, Sec. 6 and the N.E.1/4, Sec. 7, 24-5, I beg to advise that the former quarter section contains 160.32 acres and the upset price thereof is \$11.00 per acre, making a total purchase of \$1,763.52. Each instalment will amount to \$176.35.

The N.E.1/4, 7, contains 160.72 acres and the upset price is \$11.00 per acre making a total of \$1,767.92. Each instalment will amount to \$176.79.
