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Ottawa, 22nd May, 1911.

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This Department has been advised by the Deputy Survey General for the Province of Alberta that an Indian woman of the Sarcee Agency named Margie Greenwood or See-mah-ye (Walking Straight) was taken to the Brandon Hospital the Insane in April last by the R.C.M.P. Police.

This woman being a treaty Indian woman, this Department will become responsible for her maintenance from the date of her admission to the above Institution.

Although this woman belongs to the Sarcee Reserve near Calgary, it appears that she was living in the Magrath district when admitted.
