Sir:-

By direction I am communicating with you regarding the payment of the principal and interest overdue on the S.V.1/4, Sec. 6, Tp. 20, Rge. 25, W-4-A, and to refer to your letter of the 19th October last stating that payment could be made when a shipment of grain could be accomplished.

It is observed that you were granted until spring in which to pay the amounts due, and I have to say that the other purchasers have been given to the first February to complete the due instalment, and if the payment be not made, the question of cancellation of the sale would be considered without again notifying them. This action is necessary, owing to the Department having numerous obligations to carry out with the Indians, which cannot be met without the purchasers first completing their payments. Owing to these circumstances you will be good enough to forward the second instalment before February first.
