I wish to refer to my previous letter of
March 22nd, 1951, in connection with the above matter.

I am now pleased to advise that the proposed
fishway has been discussed with the Indians, and at
a meeting convened for that purpose, a Resolution
was unanimously passed granting permission to your
Department to enter the Reserve for the purposes of
carrying out the preliminary survey.

When reporting the result of the meeting,
Commissioner Arneil did not indicate whether or not
he had informed your field staff that they could
now proceed with the said preliminary survey.
