in the Countries reserved by the King for their Hunting and
now arrived at my particular Province Now if the said
Doth well and truly

in all things conform to and observe the Several Restrictions
and regulations required in his Majesty's Proclamation dated
at St James the Seventh day of October, one thousand Seven
hundred and Sixty three and also Such further orders and
Regulations as may hereafter be made by his Majesty's
Superintendent for Indian affairs, or any other the Kings
Officers Serving in these Countries who are properly
authorized to Make Rules and Regulations for the Indian
trade; then this obligation to be void or else to remain in
full force and Virtue.
