Mr Radell's second offer as now accepted is * 6.50 per 1000ft plus 50% of the overage of *35.00 the other 50% going to the contractor. This is still not equal to our original offer when the quality of timber is considered. It is estimated that 40 to 50% of the timber will sell over the *35.00 and this is where the Indians will make their money mostly.

On three different occasions we have been told that the contract was closed, but up until this last time have proved that it was not.

So. night I received a phone call from But Mack, the chiefs son, and he mentioned that the boys were not satisfied with the way things were and would like to have this gone into again.
