Another charmer, advertising his wares in a newspaper of recent date, claims he can by administering a few radium tablets, make a person immune from all pro vailing diseases; with this he thedwss in for good measure a guarantee of long tife and happiness. They have never made an examination into the facts of economic life. Not understanding the cause, they cannot give a scientific analysis. Their curea, remedies and wares, are e9. per eegt hocus pocus, and in many cases thay havebeen proved netionlx, upelegs but harmful. Whe elaim theme conjurocs are of no nse to society in general; we also assert that from a working class viewpotat they are like a lion in our patha general hindrance-and an all around nuisance. At all times they have been amongat the standardbearers of renetion and are with the staunehest supperters of engitalitpen today.
