CAP. I.

An Act to amend the Law relative to Duties of Customs.

[25th April, 1849.]

THEREAS it is expedient to amend the law relative to Duties of Customs, and Preamble. for that purpose to repeal one and to repeal in part and to amend another of the Acts hereinafter mentioned: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, intituled, An Act to re-unite the Provinces of Upper and Lower Canada, and for the Government of Canada, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the Act passed in the Session held in the tenth and Act 10 & 11 eleventh years of Her Majesty's Reign, and intituled, An Act to amend an error in the parts of c. 31 Act of the present Session, imposing Duties of Customs, and the third and fifteenth of the same Session resections of the Act passed in the said Session, and intituled, An Act for repealing and pealed, consolidating the present Duties of Customs in this Province, and for other purposes therein mentioned, and the Schedule to the said Act annexed, containing the Table of Duties of Customs inwards and Table of Exemptions and list of articles prohibited to be imported, and so much of any other part of the Act last mentioned or of any other Act or law, as shall be inconsistent with this Act, shall be, and the said Act, Schedule and enactments are hereby repealed.

II. And be it enacted, That in lieu and instead of the Duties of Customs imposed by New Duties the Act last above mentioned, and of all other Duties of Customs upon Goods, Wares and Merchandize imported into this Province, there shall be raised, levied, collected and levied under 10 imported into this Province, or taken out of work and stream of those with the collected and levied under 10 imported into this Province, or taken out of work are said Merchandize to 1 v. c. 31. paid unto Her Majesty, Her Heirs and Successors, upon Goods, Wares and Merchandize imported into this Province, or taken out of warehouse for consumption therein, the several Duties of Customs respectively inserted, described and set forth in the Table in the Schedule A. to this Act annexed, intituled, "Table of Duties of Customs inwards;" and that the articles enumerated or mentioned in the Table in the said Schedule, intituled, "Table of Exemptions," may be imported without payment of any duty Exemptions. under this Act and the Act last above mentioned; and that the articles enumerated or mentioned in the Table in the said Schedule, intituled, "Table of Prohibitions," shall Prohibitions. not be imported into this Province, under the penalty therein mentioned, and if imported shall be forfeited, and forthwith destroyed.
