An ACT for the better discovering and more effectually supressing Unlicenced Houses.

HERE AS divers idle and ill-disposed Persons in this Prowince, do Jell and retail Rum, Brandy, Wine, Cyder, Perry, and other spirituous and strong Liquors, and keep common Tipling-Houses, there inharbouring and entertaining Soldiers, Sailors, and Servants, to the weakening and destroying His Majesty's Forces in this Province, and promoting Prophineness and Debauckeries:

Be it enacted by his Excellency the Governor, Council and Affembly, and by the Authority of the same it is hereby enacted and declared, That if any Person or Persons whatsoever within this Province, shall sell any Rum, Brandy, Wine, Ale, Beer, Cyder, Perry, or other strong Liquors, mixt or unmixt, by whatever Name or Names they are or may be called or di stinguissed, without Licence first had and obtained for that Purpose, as heretofore bath been used, or as shall hereaster be directed and appointed by his Excellency the Governor and General Affembly of this Provine: or thall hawk, tell, or expose to Sale, any such Liquors unmixt or mixt; by whatever Name or Names they are or may be called or distinguished, about the Streets, Wharves, Highways, Lanes, or Suburbs of the Town of Ha.ifax, or any other Town or Place whatsoever, within this Province, in any Wheelbarrow or Balket, or upon the Water, in any Ship, Boat, or Vessel, or in any other Manner whatsoever; or shall sell or expose the same to sale on any Bolk of Bulks. Stall or Stalls or they shall forfeit Sheds, or on, or in any other Place of Flaces, ne, the or they shall forfeit for every such Offence the Sum of Ten Pounds Currency of this Province. And it shall and pay be lawful for any one Justice of the Peace for this Province, on his own View, or on Confession of the Party, or by Proof on the Oath of one credible Winnels, to convict any Person or Persons so offending; and the Person or Persons so convicted, shall immediately on fuch, and every other like Conviction, pay the faid Sum of Ten Pounds into the Hands of thich Juffice, and on with Offender or Offenders neglecting or refusing to pay the said Sum, the Justice so convicting, shall by Warrant under his Hand and Seal, commit the Offender or Offenders to His Majesty's Goal within the County where the said offence sha'l be committed, there to remain in close Confinement for the Space of Two Months. from the Day of the laid Commitments. And such Person or Persons shall have paid the laid Sum of readly or until the full Expiration of the faid Two Months. And all onics stiffing from the Conviction of any Person or Persons as aforefaid, in vale there be no informer, shall be wholly paid to the Treasurer of this rovince, and applied to be Use of His Marshy's Government; But if deere shall Be an Informet, one Molety of such Money shall be pair to The fild Informer, and the other Moiety to the land Treaturer, and appli-The Use of His Majesty's Government as atoresaids
