SYNOPSIS OF CANADIAN WEST LAND REGULA ANY PERSON who is the owner of any land in the West may homestead a quarter section of Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must be a person at the time of entry or a person at the time of entry by proxy may be an intending homesteader. Duties—Six months' residence on the land in each year. A homesteader may at least 20 acres, solely owned by him or by his father, daughter, brother, sister, or any one of them. In certain districts a homesteader may pre-empt 80 acres. Duties—Must be the homesteader or pre-emption
