Mr. McLean, was born at North Sydney fifty seven years ago, when quite a young man he removed to the United States and lived there about 15 years. His parents came to Kentville over 20 years ago and purchased the large farm of J. S. Bevin, and Mr. Peter McLean returned from the United States and has been farming here since. He was a man of quiet unassuming habits but interested in the betterment of his fellow citizens. He was elected to the Town Council and was an intelligent and hard working member of the Council Board for five years. Honest, straightforward and kind in all his dealings he has won a place high in the esteem of his fellow men.

The parents died here many years ago. One sister died 16 months ago. There are surviving Mr. McLean three brothers and one sister: John and W. Seward and Annie A. resided with him on the farm and Charles lives in California.
