JAPAN AND RUSSIA.

This world has never seen a more striking or significant contrast between two nations than is presented just now by Japan and Russia. After a gigantic struggle in which Japan was uniformly victorious because of better preparation, higher military skill, and more self-sacrificing patriotism, her people have settled down to the task of restoring their country to a state of prosperity, while Russia is a seething cauldron of political revolution and her industrial recuperation is seriously retarded. To all appearance the Japanese will have obliterated all traces of the bad effects of the war long before the Russians have well begun their difficult task.

The contrast between the two empires is not due to the amount of natural resources they respectively possess, for Russia far exceeds Japan in area, population and economic opportunities. It is not due to the lack of intelligence and endurance in the Russian people, for in both they might fairly rival the Japanese if they had a chance. It seems to be due to the respective political organizations of the two countries. Russia is an autocracy; Japan is a constitutional


