Mr. G. T. Strong is in possession of a German sterling silver ring which is causing much comment. The ring was taken from the finger of a German soldier who was taken a prisoner of war by the allies and laced was attacked by fever which caused his death. The nurse gave the ring to a Canadian soldier who was a few weeks later taken a prisoner of war in Germany, and the ring taken from his finger. Later the ring was redeemed by an American soldier who brought it to Niagara Falls, N. Y., and presented it to Mr. Strong on Wednesday.

The town of Merriton now owns a new steam road roller, the council having decided to be independent of neighbors, and to be in a position to make their own roads in their own way and at their own time. One of the factors in reaching the conclusion to buy one was that the municipalities owning machines were all using them at the same time, the road working season. So Merriton decided to buy one and be independent.

**FLIGHT AGAIN ABANDONED**  
Adverse Winds and Dark Nights Hold Airmen.

St. John's Nfld., May 13—With adverse winds reported the whole way across the Atlantic the British airmen here abandoned flying yesterday.

The general belief now is that they are purposely waiting full moon on Wednesday. Messages from Trepansey say American airmen will test their new motors this afternoon, and if satisfactory may fly immediately but weather experts here think the conditions are unpropitious for them.

**TRIUMPHANT MARCH**  
Paris, May 13—A triumphal march of the allied armies through Paris will take place on June 5, according to the present understanding. The event will occur on that date it is believed, even should the peace treaty not have been signed at that time.

**SOLDIERS CALLED OUT TO QUELL RIOTERS**

Windsor, May 13—Aid of a corps of militia from London to quell rioting in connection with the strike of the employees of the Sandwich, Windsor and Amherstburg Street Railway, control of which has been found beyond the powers of the civil authorities, was requested yesterday afternoon of Brig-Gen. Shannon, officer commanding Military District No. 1. The request was forwarded by Mayors of the five border municipalities affected.

**STILL HANG ON TO KAISER**  
Dutch Government Denies It Is Ready To Surrender Him

The Hague, May 15.—The Dutch Government denies that it has decided to surrender former Emperor William. The question at present, it contends, concerns only Germany and the cabinet.

New York, May 15.—The Mauretania, which reached here Saturday afternoon from Halifax, made a record trip from the Nova Scotian port to New York in 26 hours, 12 hours better than the fastest traffic perform the journey.

**KOREA ASKS FREEDOM**  
Wants to be Independent of Japan—Claim Made at Paris.

Paris, May 13—A petition from the Korean people and nation asking for liberation from Japan was submitted to the Peace Conference today by representatives of Korea. The petition also asks for recognition of Korea as an independent State and for the nullification of the treaty of August, 1910.

The Royal George docked at Halifax and the Cassinette at Montreal.

**OLYMPIC SAILS**  
London, May 13—The Olympic sail-boat from Southampton Saturday evening with 5,000 Canadian soldiers on board. The circumstances combined to give her quite a dramatic departure, for in addition to the civic farewell by the Lord Mayor and a great crowd of cheering people in the gathering twilight, the huge steamer had to clear without the aid of tugs on account of a strike of their crews.

Mrs. W. Gill, a baby farmer, operating without a civic license, is being held by the police on a charge of having lost one of the babies entrusted to her care.
