Warning is hereby given that the word "Icegrain" is the exclusive Trade Mark of THE SUDBURY WATERPROOF SEAL AND LEATHER MANUFACTURING COMPANY, LIMITED, and that every attempt to sell as "Icegrain" any leather or manufactured product of leather which is not manufactured by the Sudbury Company is a fraud and will be prosecuted as such.

Every side of the "Icegrain" leather manufactured by the Sudbury Company is stamped in many places on its inside with the word "Icegrain". Of this all manufacturers of boots and shoes are required to take notice. Sealers may protect themselves from imposition by demanding at the shops boots made of "Ice-
grain" leather. If any substitute is then palmed off on them it is grain" leather. If any substitute is then palmed off on them it is
a fraud, and persons who are so deceived are requested to coma fraud, and persons who are so deceived are requested to com-
municate with the Sudbury Company. Further, all sealers' boots made of "Teegrain" leather can be identified by the stamp "Icegrain" which appears in several places on the leg of the boot and is easily to be perceived.

The Trade is particularly warned that every attempt to sell as "cegrain any leather or manufactured product of leather
which is not maiaufactured by THE SUDBURY WATERPROOF SEAL AND LEATHER MANUFACTURING COMPANY, LIMITED, will be rggorously prosecuted.

The proprietors of the Trade Mark "Icegrain" are determined to protect the public and themselves against every effort to impose upon our people as "Icegrain" leather which are not the manufacture of the Sudbury Company.

The Waterproof and enduring qualities which have won such fame for "Icegrain" leather in the past will still be found in all genuine "Icegrain" leather, and in genuine "Icegrain" leather alone. These qualities cannot be imitated by any competitors.
The Sudbury Company stands at the back of the "Icegrain" leather it manufactures. It cannot be expected to stand at the back of leathers which never saw their tannery
