We wish to make a few comparisons so that these can figure out whether they got value received One thousand cards distributed One thousand cards distributed about town will be read by not more than one thousand persons old and young, and then cast aside. The same amount spent on circular would pay for, from 1000 to 1500 and on this each merchant could put ter times the amount reading matter, and these would be read by as many if not more people. For the amount paid this stranger, each of these merchants could have placed a ten inch advt, in the Graphic for three weeks. The Graphic prints about two thousand copies each week or a total of about six thousand, copies in 3 weeks. In ten inches for three weeks, with the option of changing each week, the merchant chinging each week, the merchan could put about five times as much reading and tell three different stries or fifteen times as much as this card.
