certainly resign his office as Governorill certainly resign his office as Governo General of Alsace-Lorraine, but that his retirement is in no way connected with publishing. Princess Hohenlohe has succeeded to the Russian estates of her brother, Prince Sayn Vittgenstein, which are worth £50,000 year; but, according to a recent unuse, foreigners cannot hold land in Russia, and the Czar has refused to exempt Prince and Princess Hohenlohe from this regulation, so it has been decided that the estates are to pass to their younger son, Prince Alexander Hohenlohe, who will assume the name of Wittgenstein and become a Russian subject. 
